Current students in UVU masters programs will expand their knowledge and experience in higher education leadership through 9 credit hours of coursework to earn this certificate. This certificate is relevant for anyone interested in careers in higher education and higher education adjacent sectors.

Matriculation Requirements

Acceptance into a UVU Master's program or acceptance into the Graduate Certificate in Leading With Higher Education program by meeting the following minimum requirements:

A bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college/university, a nationally accredited program, or the international equivalent.

A 3.0 cumulative undergraduate GPA or a 3.0 GPA calculated on the last 60 semester hours (90 quarter hours) of undergraduate work.
